JUDGE: The student category of this show will be judged by an ACOLM committee.

ELIGIBILITY: This student category is open to all students, grades 6 to 12, who work in Drawing, Watercolor, Mixed Media, Oil, Acrylic, Pastel, Photography, and Sculpture. All works must be original and may not have been previously submitted to this show. Art must be independently created. No artwork from printed material or other artist's work, or work done with a teacher's assistance will be accepted. No work will be accepted that has had hands-on contact by anyone other than the submitting artist.

AWARDS: Cash Prizes will be awarded at the artist's reception.

\$100.00 -First Place

\$50.00 -Second Place

\$25.00 -Third Place

Honorable Mention ribbons and Merchandise Awards are issued at the judge's discretion. There must be at least 10 entries in this category, or they will be combined with the adult category.

SPECIFICATIONS: Work must be dry, framed, and ready to hang. 'Wrap Around' or 'Box' canvases do not need to be framed if all sides are painted. Works requiring special assembly, handling, and/or installation will not be accepted. Contact Victoria Pflanzner (562-746-6180) if you have questions.

All images must be family-appropriate. The City of La Mirada and ACOLM reserve the right to refuse any image based on inappropriate content. Works considered unsafe or the judges believe to be unsuitable for public viewing will not be accepted.

ENTRY FEES: No entry fee for middle and high school students. Artists will be permitted to submit no more than 2 entries. *Teachers submitting students' art will be permitted to submit no more than 10 entries per school.*

SALES: A 10% sales commission will be retained by ACOLM, so price your work accordingly.

LIABILITY: Entries will be handled with great care, however, ACOLM and the City of La Mirada will not be responsible for any loss or damage. Accepted entries must remain in the gallery until the end of the show.
